Barbara Joy: On the call of the roll the vote was as follows: yes 2-0 no. Motion passed.

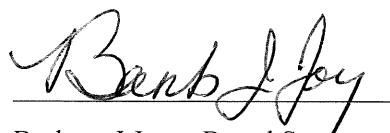
