**INTRODUCTION OF ORDINANCE WITH 1<sup>ST</sup> AND 2<sup>ND</sup> READING APPROVED:**


**ORDINANCE 5-19 – AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1141, ORDINANCE NO. 2439 AND ORDINANCE NO. 36-63 OF THE CITY OF ANDERSON, MADISON COUNTY, INDIANA WITH RESPECT TO A CHANGE IN THE ZONE MAP AS TO CERTAIN REAL ESTATE WITHIN THE CITY OF ANDERSON, AS HEREIN PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED.** COUNCILMAN BIBBS MOVED THE ORDINANCE BE GIVEN FINAL READING, SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN DIXON – READ BY CITY CLERK. MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANT DIRECTOR, TIM STIRES REPRESENTED THE ORDINANCE. THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 2201 HILLCREST DR. TO BE REZONED FROM R-2 TO R-4. ATTORNEY MIKE AUSTIN ALSO WAS IN ATTENDANCE AND SPOKE REGARDING THE ORDINANCE. THERE WERE SEVERAL QUESTIONS AND COMMENTS FROM COUNCIL. QUESTION CALLED BY COUNCILMAN STEPHENSON. **ORDINANCE 3-19 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1141, ORDINANCE NO. 2439, AND ORDINANCE NO. 36-63 OF THE CITY OF ANDERSON, MADISON COUNTY, INDIANA, WITH RESPECT TO A CHANGE IN THE ZONE MAP AS TO CERTAIN REAL ESTATE WITHIN THE CITY OF ANDERSON, AS HEREIN PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED.** COUNCILMAN DIXON MOVED THE ORDINANCE BE GIVEN 1<sup>ST</sup> READING, SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN STEPHENSON – READ BY CITY CLERK. THERE WERE QUESTIONS FROM COUNCIL. QUESTION CALLED BY COUNCILMAN DIXON. ON THE CALL OF THE ROLL THE VOTE WAS AS FOLLOWS: AYES 8 – NAYS 0. ORDINANCE 3-19 PASSED FIRST READING PASSED.
