BUSINESS

Mr. Dixon: Second.

Trinna Simmons: On the call of the roll the vote was as follows: yes 2-0 no. Motion passed.

CLAIMS TO BE PAID

POLICE DEPARTMENT

Mr. McKinley: Mike, you have policies to review?

Chief Mike Lee: Yes, General order 94-06, Employee Appearance Standards. General Order 94-08, Recruitment Selection and General order 95-04, Commendations and awards. There are just some wording changes. Appearance, Business casual. Commendation and awards, Life-saving award, we have had it for some time. They now will also get four days off as reward. Recruitment, now it states you can use electronic mail, it was originally written in 1994 before electronic mail exists.

Chief David Cravens: We are here today to seek approval to negotiate a new truck with Fire Apparatus. The truck that will be replaced is engine 7. The truck is 13 years old and has two transmissions

MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT

Trinna Simmons: We bring before you 2026 Main St. We have heard from him a couple times on Zoom. Todd Fisher is off on medical. He asked me to present this to find out what is going on with the property. They have a current permit that is do to expire in May. They are here.

Jessica Sanchez: I am the daughter of Martina Garcia and Guadalupe Sanchez. My dad has a potential buyer.

Trinna Simmons: They had the property all cleaned up. Due to the weather the building is kinda falling off into the neighboring yards Todd wants to know what the intentions are.

Jessica Sanchez: He has diabetes. He knows he is getting behind on that. He has a potential buyer and we are waiting to see if he agrees to buying the property. He is coming to see the property tomorrow or Wednesday. We will have an answer after that.

Mike McKinley: Trinna when does the permit expire?

Trinna Simmons: May.

Mr. McKinley: What to let them come back in 30 days?

Trinna Simmons: May 9th, 2022

Mr. McKinley: ok, we see them back on May 9th

Trinna Simmons: The other property is 1500 W 2nd St. The old bus garage, but the lady is not here.

Mr. Dixon: Why don't we set both of these cases for May 9th

Mr. McKinley: This is tabled until May 9th, 2022. We are also getting phone calls again for 2520 East 6th.

Trinna Simmons: They cleaned it up enough that Todd allowed them to get building permits. We are getting complaints also. Environmental has sent them letters again. Do you want me to set that one up for May 9th also?


Mr. McKinley: Yes, do it. May 9th
