OPENING OF MEETING: THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANDERSON, MADISON COUNTY, INDIANA, MET ON THURSDAY APRIL 14TH, 2022 AT 6:00 P.M. IN THE ANDERSON CITY HALL AUDITORIUM AND VIA ZOOM, WITH PRESIDENT REBECCA CRUMES PRESIDING

ORDINANCE FOR THIRD READING:

ORDINANCE 3-22 – AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1141, AND ORDINANCE NO. 36-63 OF THE CITY OF ANDERSON, MADISON COUNTY, INDIANA WITH RESPECT TO A CHANGE IN THE ZONE MAP AS TO CERTAIN REAL ESTATE WITHIN THE CITY OF ANDERSON, AS HEREIN PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED. COUNCILMAN MUIR MOVED THE ORDINANCE BE GIVEN THIRD READING, SECONDED BY COUNCILWOMAN CULP – READ BY CITY CLERK. TIM STIRES, MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANT DIRECTOR REPRESENTED THE ORDINANCE. THE REAL ESTATE LOCATED AT 215 W 8TH STREET, BE REZONED FROM B-5 TO R-4. THERE WERE NO QUESTIONS. QUESTION CALLED BY COUNCILWOMAN CULP.
