OPENING OF MEETING: THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANDERSON, MADISON COUNTY, INDIANA, MET ON THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 15TH, 2022 AT 6:00 P.M. IN THE ANDERSON CITY HALL WITH PRESIDENT REBECCA CRUMES PRESIDING
