Mr. Clendenen: I make a motion to approve the removal of the trailer at formally 1925 Morton St

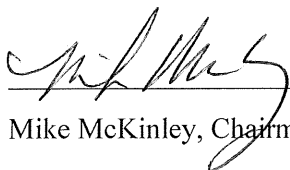
Mr. McKinley: Second
